About the Artist

Complexity and balance come together in the works of Italian photographer **Stefano Bertolucci**, as he captures the essence of the scene in his urban and rural landscapes and figural studies of dancers in motion. At once crisp and soft, Bertolucci's images are rich in an emotionally expressive and painterly use of color and light. Remaining ever modern with a classically inspired elegance, the artist studies a limitless variety of subjects as part of his own personal vision of form and design, pushing the boundaries of photography through experimental shooting and processing techniques. Each of Bertolucci's digital images is printed on Hannemule photo rag pearl paper, released as a large scale, limited edition of 20.

He currently living in Bologna, Italy and teaches at the High School of Photography and Visual Arts in Padua. Stefano Bertolucci began his career as a self-taught newspaper photographer. He has since moved on to build a name for himself in the wide-ranging fields of advertising, theatre, nature, science and now fine art photography.
